Young Russian ship financier Egor Ryabchenko has won the TradeWinds photo contest with a picture of a ship his father designed.

Ryabchenko originally from St Petersburg but now based in Rotterdam scooped 34% of the votes with a photo of an ice encrusted 5,000-dwt sea-river general cargo vessel, Rusich-5, on the Baltic Sea.

The 26 year old is a graduate of Makarov State Maritime Academy and has just completed a maritime economics and logistics MSc at Erasmus University.

He works for FinShip BV as an associate of this Rotterdam ship finance boutique, that arranged the financing of the Rusich-5.

Egor says he is particularly proud that TradeWinds readers chose his photo to be the winning entry as his father, Alexander Ryabchenko, was one of the main designers of this ship series.

A 10.2m pixel Nikon D80 with an 18mm-135mm zoom lens and the TradeWinds' Maritime Photographer of the Year trophy will soon be on its way to Egor.

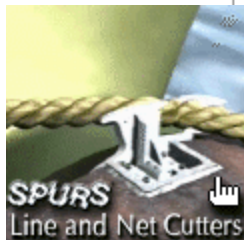
